

WHITES

Chardonnay, Kendall Jackson, California - \$30 / \$9.00 GI

Rich layering of flavors from grapes grown in California's cool coastal vineyards. Ripe red apple and pear with luscious citrus notes.

Chardonnay/KARIA, Stag's Leap Wine Cellars, Ca - \$49

Aromas of ripe, fresh pear & cinnamon-spiced Golden Delicious apples with a hint of caramel.

Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Italy - \$46

A fresh, clean fragrance that is followed by a crisp, refreshing flavor.

Pinot Grigio, Ruffino, Italy - \$25 / \$7.50 GI

Notes of meadow flowers, pears, and golden apples with a touch of minerality.

Pouilly Fuissé, Bouchard, France - \$39

Light nutty, citrus, flinty/mineral, green apple, delicate floral nose with yeasty notes; dry, medium bodied, with fresh fruit, vanilla and melon.

Riesling, Chateau Ste Michelle, Washington - \$24 / \$7.50 GI

This "everyday" Riesling offers crisp apple aromas w. subtle minerality.

Riesling, RK, Germany - \$29

Fragrances of white peach, apple & grapefruit harmonize with a fresh mineral texture - perfect balance of sweetness & acidity with a dry finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Kim Crawford, New Zealand - \$35

Citrus & Tropical fruits backed by characteristic herbaceous notes for which Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is renowned.

Sauvignon Blanc, Kono, New Zealand- \$25/ \$7.50 GI

Luscious fruit flavors of citrus, ripe tropical fruits, and lifted herbaceous notes are finely balanced with zesty acidity, an underlying minerality.

SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNES

Asti Spumante, Martini & Rossi, Italy - \$25

A fruity sparkling wine, low in acidity, fresh, fruity & highly aromatic.

Brut, Korbel, California - \$27

Crisp & refreshing, w/ light citrus and fresh pear-like note in the finish.

Cava Brut, Gran Sarao, Spain - \$24

A nose of biscuit, apple, and floral notes leading to a dry, fruity mid-palate. This well-balanced bubbly has a lengthy, refreshing finish.

Dom Perignon, Moet & Chandon, France - \$235

The palate is seductive, richly flavorful and smooth with a delicate fresh crispness.

Imperial, Moet & Chandon, France - \$79

Vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit, the freshness of mineral nuances and white flowers the elegance of blond notes.

Moscato D'Asti, Cupcake, Italy- \$24 / \$7.50 GI

Vibrant and expressive with hints of floral notes and bright fruit flavors including peach, and tropical fruits.

Prosecco, LaLuca, Italy- \$28 / \$8.00 GI

Bold orchard fruits, crisp pears, and lemon curd, all of which come together in a rich off-dry style that is extremely appealing.

REDS

Amarone, Sartori, Italy - \$64

Dried fruits, raisins, cherry compote with cocoa notes. Round & full-bodied; deep fruit flavors, and supple tannins; a cinnamon spice finish.

Beaujolois-Villages, Louis Jadot, France - \$26

This crisp, fruit-forward, juicy wine has expressive aromas and flavors of ripe red berries, with nice weight in the mouth.

Cabernet Sauvignon, R Mondavi Private Select, Ca-\$25 /\$7.50 GI

Opaque garnet color with ripe red fruit, oak, and vanilla aromas. It's light bodied, smooth and easy with plum, cherry, and vanilla flavors.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Simi, California - \$45

Compelling flavors of cassis, cherry and plum along with black pepper, cedar, and clove add life to this full-bodied yet silky wine.

Chianti, Ruffino Superiore, Italy - \$25

Ruby red in color, offers inviting wild fruit characteristics and a balanced structure with soft tannins set off by bright acidity.

Malbec, Terrazas De Los Andes, Argentina – \$27 / \$8.00 GI

Young, vibrant and balanced, this deep red wine with purplish shades boasts ripe red fruits such as raspberry, blackberry and plum.

Merlot, 14 Hands, Washington - \$24 / \$7.50 GI

Aromas of dark stone fruits & cherries with subtle notes of herbs. Flavors of plum, black cherry, blackberries & spice complemented by soft, polished tannins.

Pinot Noir, J Lohr, California- \$25 / \$8.50 GI

Varietal aromas of black cherry, strawberry, & dried herbs lifted by vanilla spice.

Pinot Noir, Villa Maria, New Zealand- \$35

Red cherry and bright berry fruits abound on the nose, whilst on the palate the wine displays succulent fruit with complex spice.

Red Blend, Ménage a Trois, California- \$24

Zinfandel, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon are perfectly blended together to add complexity and create a full-bodied, versatile wine.

Shiraz, Jacob's Creek, Australia - \$24 / \$7.50 GI

Medium bodied in structure, with ripe plum flavors, good mid palate fruit sweetness and rich yet soft, velvety tannins through to the finish.

Tempranillo, Torres Celeste, Spain - \$38

Liquorice and black pepper hints on a base of well-ripened fruits. Very fruity at first with ripened tannins, also persistent and full bodied.

Zinfandel, Unabashed, Motto, California- \$28

Dark & complex, this Zinfandel starts off with a soft, leathery aroma & finishes with flavors of chocolate-covered raspberries & a hint of spice.

BLUSH/ROSÉ

Rosé, Vivanco, Spain- \$22 / \$7.50 GI

Aromas of fresh strawberries and raspberries are accented by hints of licorice and rose petal.

White Zinfandel, Beringer, California - \$18 / \$6.50 GI

Fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors.
